
IVEY MBA STUDENTS ON EXCHANGE

Academic exchanges are available in the Winter term only. MBA students must complete the 4.5 elective credits required for MBA students to meet graduation requirements. MBA Direct students must take 6.0 elective credits to meet graduation requirements:

MBA students interested in an exchange term, must pre-register in 9 Ivey electives in the Fall + December Condensed combined. MBA direct students interested in an exchange term must pre-register in 11 Ivey electives in the Fall + December Condensed combined. At the same time, students may apply to the Exchange Program. Successful candidates can drop their winter term electives once confirmed into the program.

Term at Ivey – Students planning to go on exchange take 9471 – Leading Critical Issues Project course in place of Capstone 2 in February. This course has already been scheduled for 1 full Saturday in November (check the Timetable) MBA Students must take 6 elective courses at Ivey in the Fall Term and 4 elective course equivalents while on exchange. MBA Direct students must take 8 elective courses at Ivey (this includes the special elective offerings in July/August) in the Fall Term + December Condensed and 4 elective course equivalents while on exchange.

*MBA Study Trip = 0.75 elective credits

*Leadership Under Fire = 0.75 elective credits

Please Note: The minimum number of courses that a student on exchange can take is 4 elective course equivalents (3.0 credits) regardless of whether or not you have overloaded prior to the exchange and/or do not require as many business credits. Students must be in good academic and financial standing, have a minimum of 74.0% grade average, and be a good ambassador for Ivey.
